NEW WAYS TO SHARE THE LOVE OF CHRIST IN INDIA

Twenty-five pastor and evangelist couples from South India recently gathered for community health training in Mumbai. We were there in partnership with Teach to Transform.

The training includes basics: health and hygiene, vital signs, wound and burn care, safe deliveries, and newborn care at birth, particularly if the baby isn't breathing.

The students were very eager to learn. We tested their knowledge at the end of the week, had a graduation, and presented each couple with a "starter kit." The kits contain blood pressure cuffs and other equipment that enable them to implement what they have learned. This is a proven method that demonstrates the love and compassion of Christ and opens doors to sharing the gospel.

Most of these students work in "hard-to-reach" communities and many have met significant resistance while attempting traditional ministry approaches. During the training, they are taught simple but complete ways to integrate sharing the gospel and caring for physical needs. Offering blood pressure readings opens doors for conversations and relationships all over the world.

Our host in the Mumbai area reports, "Just want to encourage you that our recent students have started working in a big way. In just a week we have started 5 cell groups and over 200 people have heard the gospel. Overall, from October till now 11,515 people have heard the gospel and we have planted 58 house churches and cell groups. In the past 7 months, we have reached 70-plus new villages and slums."

IMMEDIATE RESULTS: Two students from the Mumbai training were traveling back to their home village aboard a train. The train lurched and a fellow passenger fell. He hit his head and began bleeding quite profusely.

The student from our training was carrying his new start-up medical kit and promptly said, "I can take care of you." He took out his wound care items, cleaned the injury, applied ointment and a bandage, then shared the gospel with the man.
